Dear Student and Parents of Candidates for Confirmation,

Welcome to confirmation, which will enhance your spiritual growth in your relationship with God and your fellow Catholics.

The Faith Formation program you are beginning this year has been especially designed to guide you to becoming an adult Catholic in the 21st century. The presumption of this program is that God is first in your life and will take precedence over any other activities. Putting God as the least important person in our lives is compromising our faith experience.

It is my expectation that you will give one hundred percent of your energies to becoming a faith filled Catholic adult. There are many distractions in life that will constantly try to pull us away from a rich faith experience. It is my hope that these two years will help to give you a good basis for meeting those distractions and not letting them triumph over you. We have a very rich faith tradition. Every class is important and will help you have a fuller understanding of who we are as a faith community. Any classes that are missed, a typed paper needs to be given to me on the subject matter for that class.

We ask each student to find an adult in this church to mentor you during these two years. This person can be your sponsor or your mentor. Your mentor and/or sponsor needs to be in good standing with the Catholic Church. If you need help finding a person I will gladly help you find your mentor.

We need your help, for your child to take these two years seriously they need to know you are serious. How better to do just that, than by volunteering as a teacher, being a chaperone, or to work with our Youth Board. The success of this program is a vital part of your child becoming a lifelong catholic. We need you to pray over this confirmation program and please accept the responsibility of the requirements outlined on the Commitment page in the Confirmation Handbook. We strongly suggest that your child should also carefully pray and think on their responsibility in taking these classes. If, your child is not ready to fully participate in these classes we should discuss deferring this Sacrament until a time when they are able to fully participate.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

WHAT IS THIS SACRAMENT:

Baptism, the Eucharist and the Sacrament of Confirmation together constitute the “Sacraments of Christian Initiation”. Confirmation is a very important step on your spiritual journey. A step that is up to you and how it will change your relationship with Christ forever.

Many think that Confirmation is simply a rite of passage into Catholic adulthood, but it is much more than that. Confirmation brings you an increase in the grace given to you at Baptism; it allows you to be a courageous leader to practice your faith and it also calls for you to stand up for what is just. Being confirmed will give you a permanent spiritual mark, which is characterized by the dwelling of the Holy Spirit in you and to be counted as a life-long follower of Christ.

REQUIREMENTS AND YOUR COMMITMENT TO THIS SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM:

St. Anne Confirmation program is a two-year program with the celebration of the Sacrament by the Bishop in one of our churches in the Deanery. Each candidate and parent or guardian is asked to sign this letter of requirements. Please understand that you are making a promise to involve yourself and meet the following required participation commitments.

1. Attend Mass each Sunday and on Holy Days. . . the center of the Church’s life.
2. Meet the class attendance requirements of 85% (or missing no more than four days per year) a missed class needs a typed paper on the subject matter missed, and involvement in class projects, which includes presentation of the Stations of the Cross, Easter Triduum, and two Deanery Retreats in your first and second year and special events that come up.
3. Participate in Youth Masses once a month.
4. Actively participate in Post Confirmation to service Parish in the form of working with Faith Formation Teachers, Youth Representative on Parish Council, Lector, Greeting-Gift Bearing, Usher, or Altar Server.
5. Participate in the Youth Board.
6. Each year of Confirmation preparation you will volunteer at least 40 hours. (20 to the church and 20 to the community)

_____ **Proof of Baptism.** Receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation will complete your Christian Initiation. In order to do this we must have proof of your Baptism.

_____ **Acceptance of Candidacy.** All the necessary persons are required to sign this form and the student will bring it to class.

_____ **Sponsor Information.** Your sponsor needs to fill in the necessary information and the student will bring this form to class. A due date will be assigned for this form during the First year.

_____ **Confirmation Name.** Complete this form and bring it to class. A due date will be assigned for this form during the second year.

_____ **Statement of Desire to be Confirmed.** This form will be completed in class during the second year.

S P O N S O R

To emphasize the unity of the Sacrament of Baptism and Confirmation, and if possible, it is encouraged that the sponsor be one of the baptismal Godparents.

REQUIREMENTS: The sponsor needs to have completed the initiation process (received Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist). The person must be at least sixteen years of age, confirmed and must obtain a letter of recommendation from their own Pastor (if not presently a member of St. Anne's parish). The sponsor may not be a parent. This letter from your Sponsor's Parish tells us that your Sponsor is a Confirmed, practicing Catholic who is free and able to carry out this responsibility. If Sponsors are students who are away at College, they too must obtain a letter of recommendation.

ROLE: The Sponsor is to assist in the preparation of the candidate for this Sacrament, to present the candidate to the Bishop, and to help the candidate in the fulfillment of his/her Baptismal promises. The Sponsor should demonstrate an active and deep commitment to the Catholic Church, particularly through a serious attempt to live out the implication of the Gospel message. We encourage the sponsors to attend as many activities with the candidate as possible. Some suggestions are to attend church devotions with the student, assist with the development of the conscience, pray together, and encourage and support the student in their choice of a commitment to the Parish Community during the year following Confirmation.

CONFIRMATION NAME

Your name gives you identity. It tells others who you are. When you were baptized, your parents chose your name. If you do not know your parents' reason for choosing your name, ask them about it. Now that you wish to be confirmed, it is time to choose the name you will take as a sign of your growth in faith.

The tradition of taking on a new name to show a new role can be traced back to the Old Testament. When Abram was called to lead his people to believe in the one God, his name was changed from Abram (meaning father of many) to Abraham (meaning father of many nations). In the New Testament we find Simon's name changed to Peter (meaning rock) because he was to become the rock upon which Jesus founded His church. Again in the New Testament, Saul's name was changed to Paul upon his conversion.

Your Confirmation name should reflect your new role as a mature Christian. Perhaps you would like to take the name of a person whom you admire. Many Confirmation candidates, recognizing the growing bond of love with their parents, take a parent's name. A Godparent's or Sponsor's name would also be meaningful. You may even wish to keep your own name as a sign of the extension of your Baptismal commitment which you will make in Confirmation. Your choice of a name, however, must be a Christian name — e.g., a Saint's name or a variation of it.
